3) Trim those dances! Let's face it FOUR minutes is a really long time to watch someone dance and it will feel like a lifetime for you with everyone in the room watching you. The emotional **WOW** happens in the first couple of minutes, so why not ask your DJ to edit the song so it ends a little early.

4) Tickle the senses! Ever feel like your life is **Groundhog Day**? Go to work, get home, clean the house, wake up, do it all over again. The last thing you want is for your guests to include your wedding in that list. **Yikes!** Not exactly what we're aiming for, is it?
